Travelling with Children

Single parents or other adults travelling alone with children should be aware that some countries require documentary proof of parental responsibility to allow entry into the country and, in some cases, to allow the child to leave the country. For full information on immigration requirements, please contact the relevant Embassy of the country you are travelling to.

Advanced Passenger Information (API)

Advanced Passenger Information (API) is biographical information that is contained within the machine readable section of your passport, such as your name and passport number. Under the UK Government 'e-Borders' scheme, airlines are required to collect this information from you to pass onto the e-Borders programme before your departure from a UK airport,

and on any journey back to the UK. The UK Border Agency e-Borders programme is a legal direction to which all transport carriers must comply, and failure to provide the required data may result in carriage being denied. For some destinations, your API will be obtained at the airport, but for others the information is needed by the airline at least 72 hours prior to travel. Please ask your Worldwide Sales Executive or Travel Agent for details.

Accommodation Ratings

Rating systems are used to give a guide to the overall quality of a property. Official ratings are given by the authorities in the country each hotel is in, and these tend to give an impression of relative standards within that country. Please be aware that standards differ from country to country, so a 4* property in one country may not be equivalent to a 4* property in another. Our ratings are based on information given by hotels directly, or our overseas suppliers.

Tours

Our tours include services from many different airlines, hotels and ground transportation companies. Due to this, it is not always possible for us to guarantee specific airlines, aircraft, flights, trains, ferries and/or hotels featured in a particular itinerary. We reserve the right to change any of the services detailed within a tour itinerary and, where necessary, change the itinerary itself without prior notice. Where significant changes to an itinerary are necessary, we will give you as much advanced notice as possible. Local conditions may also mean that changes to a tour may need to be made once the tour has commenced.

Seaplane and Speedboat Transfers in the Maldives

Seaplane transfers are offered to some resorts in the Maldives, operate only in daylight hours (approximately 0800 - 1700), and do not operate in bad weather. Overnight stays in Male are needed for international flights which are scheduled to arrive/depart when transfer by seaplane is not possible. Arrangements can be made for this at the time of booking. If your international flight is delayed and you miss your onward seaplane connection, an overnight stay in Male will also be required, at your own cost. Speedboat transfers are also subject to weather conditions, and may operate a reduced schedule during night time hours.

Nights Spent in Your Accommodation

Accommodation is usually reserved for you from 1400 (destination dependant) on the day that you depart from the UK. For flights departing between 0001 and 0400 hours, the day of departure is deemed to be the previous day. In some cases, you may arrive in the early hours or during the course of the morning. In this case, your accommodation should be immediately available - this is classed as the first night of your holiday. Rooms are normally vacated at 1200 noon on the last day of the holiday, however, in some areas, this may be earlier. If you are on Half Board, Full Board or All Inclusive basis, you may lose a meal owing to your flight times.

All Inclusive/Full Board Plus Holidays

Identification: On arrival at your hotel, it is likely that you will be provided

with a form of identification, usually a card, necklace or bracelet which will have to be shown when ordering meals, drinks and other included facilities.

Behaviour: Each of the All Inclusive/Full Board Plus hotels reserve the right to withdraw the facility to any guest(s), including children, whose behaviour is considered by management to be detrimental to the enjoyment of other guests.

Alcohol: Alcoholic drinks will be freely available throughout the day, and tend to be locally produced brands. Cocktails, international premium brands, and some fruit juices may incur a charge - please ask for full details at the time of booking. Please consider other guests when using this facility, and bear in mind that hotel management reserve the right to refuse service to guests they believe to be intoxicated or under age (in accordance with local law).

Bottled Water: Please be aware that at some All Inclusive/Full Board Plus properties, bottled water is not included in the drinks service.

Snacks: The type and variety of snacks served between meals may vary between hotels and resorts, and may be of a more local/traditional variety.

We recommend that you ask at the time of booking for full and specific details of what is included in your chosen All Inclusive/Full Board Plus package.

Entertainment and Facilities

Entertainment and facilities differ from hotel to hotel, as does the quality of entertainment. Charges may be made locally for entertainment and for the use of some facilities, including sports facilities. Some facilities may also be subject to weather conditions.

In low season, some facilities may be withdrawn or have a limited supply due to lack of demand, particularly at the beginning or end of the season.

Local Areas

Areas surrounding your holiday accommodation, such as beaches, the sea, roads and mountains, do not form part of your holiday package, and will not have been inspected. It is your own responsibility to take reasonable care for your safety and the safety of your party.

Long Haul Flights

Time differences between the UK and destinations in the Indian Ocean mean that your flight will arrive up to 6 hours further ahead, so please bear this in mind when checking flight times. Long haul flights can be tiring, so we recommend that you wear comfortable clothing, and drink plenty of water.

1. **Your holiday contract**
- 1.1 Your booking is made with Hays Tour Operating Ltd (“us”, “we”), and the following terms and conditions “booking conditions”) form the basis of your contract with us. Please read them carefully as they set out our respective rights and obligations. By asking us to confirm your booking, we are entitled to assume that you have read the booking conditions and agree to them.
- 1.2 In these booking conditions, “you” and “your” means all of the people named on the booking (including anyone who is added or substituted) or any one of them, as the context requires, and “lead passenger” means the person who makes the booking.
2. **Before you book** (refer to Hays Faraway website for full booking conditions)
3. **Booking and Paying For Your Holiday**
- 3.1 When you confirm a holiday booking you must pay a deposit of either £175 per person or 10% of the holiday cost, whichever is the greater, or any higher deposit which applies to your holiday (for example if a supplier requires full payment at the time of booking). The deposit will only be refundable as set out in these booking conditions.
- 3.2 Bookings made directly on our website or within 98 days of your departure date require full payment at the time of booking.
- 3.3 Some special offer flights will need to be paid in full at time of booking and are non-refundable should you subsequently cancel. Please also refer to 4.3 (Cancelling Your Holiday).
- 3.4 After your booking is taken and a deposit received, a confirmation invoice will be sent to you detailing the total cost due. Full payment must be received not less than 98 days before departure. If we or your travel agent have not received full payment at least 98 days before departure, we reserve the right to treat your booking as cancelled by you and to retain the deposit paid. If we do not choose to treat your booking as cancelled immediately because you have promised to make payment, if you still do not make full payment the cancellation charges shown at 4.3 will become due depending on the date we reasonably treat your booking as cancelled.
- 3.5 Any supplements to be added to the cost of your holiday will be quoted to you at the time of booking. They do not necessarily indicate that any additional services will be provided.
- 3.6 We make a charge for payment by credit card. The charge will be confirmed at the time of booking.
- 3.7 We reserve the right to cancel a booking which has been made at an incorrect price. When we become aware of any such pricing error, we will notify you as soon as reasonably possible. You will be given the option of accepting the correct price for your holiday, booking an alternative holiday or receiving a full refund.
- 3.8 We will arrange to provide you with the various services which form part of the holiday you book with us. Before your booking is confirmed and a contract comes into existence, we reserve the right to increase or decrease, and correct errors in, advertised prices and to change any of the holiday details advertised. Any changes will be made known to you at the time of booking.
- 3.9 A booking is not accepted until we issue an invoice. The date shown on the invoice is the date of booking.
- 3.10 It is important to check the details on the invoice when you get it. If any details appear to be incorrect or incomplete, please contact us immediately as it may not be possible to make changes later. Any misspelled or incorrect names must be corrected. We regret we cannot accept any liability if we are not notified of any inaccuracy in any document within 10 days of our sending it out. We will do our best to rectify any mistake notified to us outside these time limits but you must meet any costs involved in doing so. We may charge a fee for any amendments.
- 3.11 **Your Financial Protection**
- 3.11.1 When you buy a flight inclusive package holiday from us it is authorised under our ATOL number 10531 and protected under the ATOL scheme.
- 3.11.2 We, or the suppliers of the services you have bought, will provide you with the services you have bought (or a suitable alternative). In some cases, where neither we nor the supplier are able to do so for reasons of insolvency, an alternative ATOL holder may provide you with the services you have bought or a suitable alternative (at no extra cost to you). You agree to accept that in those circumstances the alternative ATOL holder will perform those obligations and you agree to pay any money outstanding to be paid by you under your contract to that alternative ATOL holder. However, you also agree that in some cases it will not be possible to appoint an alternative ATOL holder, in which case you will be entitled to make a claim under the ATOL scheme (or your credit card issuer where applicable).
- 3.11.3 All money you pay to a travel agent is held by them on behalf of the Trustees of the Air Travel Trust, subject to their obligation to pay it to us as long as we do not fail. If we fail, any money held by the agent, or subsequently accepted from you by them, is and continues to be held on behalf of the Trustees of the Air Travel Trust without any obligation to pay that money to us.
- 3.12 **Out Of Date Range Flights** (refer to Hays Faraway website for full booking conditions)
- 3.13 You should take out appropriate travel insurance which provides cover against loss of deposit or cancellation fees and against medical costs. Please read your policy details carefully and take them with you on holiday.
4. **If You Want To Change Or Cancel Your Holiday**
- 4.1 **Changes Or Additions To Your Holiday**
If you want to change any part of your holiday arrangements after the invoice has been issued, we will do our best to make the change, but it may not be possible. If it is possible to make the change, it will be subject to an administration charge of £50 per booking, and payment of any further costs we incur in making this alteration. If we agree that you may change your booking to a holiday of lower value, and then you cancel that holiday, we reserve the right to levy cancellation charges on the value of the original booking. Scheduled airlines normally regard name changes as a cancellation and rebooking, and any alteration may incur a 100% cancellation charge in respect of the air fare.
- 4.2 **Transferring Bookings** (refer to Hays Faraway website for full booking conditions)
- 4.3 **Cancelling Your Holiday**
- 4.3.1 If you or anyone on your holiday booking wishes to cancel the holiday, the lead name must notify us as soon as possible. Any notification by telephone must also be confirmed in writing or by e-mail within 24 hours by the lead name. Cancellation will take effect when we are notified provided that written confirmation is received by us within 24 hours of the original notification.
- 4.3.2 The following charges will be payable depending on when the notification of cancellation is received. References to the deposit include all sums paid or payable at the time of booking.

- 4.3.3 Please also note that airline ticketing deadlines may apply, resulting in higher cancellation charges. Please ask for details at the time of booking. Insurance premiums and amendment charges are not refundable in the event of cancellation.
5. **If We Change Or Cancel Your Holiday**
- 5.1 **Flight Details** (refer to Hays Faraway website for full booking conditions)
- 5.2 **We Change Or Cancel Your Holiday Before Your Departure**
- 5.2.1 We hope and expect to be able to provide you with all the services we have confirmed to you at the time of booking. We plan arrangements a long time in advance of your holiday using independent suppliers, such as airlines and hotels, over whom we have no direct control. On occasions changes do have to be made, and we reserve the right to change or cancel your holiday at any time. If we have to make a significant change or cancel, we will tell you as soon as possible.
- 5.2.2 A significant change includes a change of accommodation to that of a lower category or price for the whole or a major part of your time away, a change of flight time of more than 12 hours, a change of UK departure airport (except between London airports), or a significant change of resort area.
- 5.2.3 We will only cancel your confirmed booking after you have made full payment where we are forced to do so by a Force Majeure Event (see 5.3) or if the minimum number of clients required for a particular travel arrangement is not reached.
- 5.2.4 Where there has been a significant change to your holiday, if there is time to do so before departure, we will offer you the choice of the following options:
5.2.4.1 accepting the changed arrangements; or
5.2.4.2 accepting an offer of alternative travel arrangements of comparable standard from us, if available (we will refund any price difference if the alternative is of a lower value); or
5.2.4.3 cancelling, in which case you will receive a full refund.
- 5.2.5 If we have to make a significant change or cancel we will pay you the compensation payments set out in the table below, unless:
5.2.5.1 we are forced to make a change or cancel by a Force Majeure Event (see 5.3);
5.2.5.2 we have to cancel because the minimum number of bookings necessary for us to operate your holiday has not been reached;
5.2.5.3 we cancel as a result of your failure to comply with any significant requirement of these booking conditions (such as making payment on time).

- 5.2.6 No compensation is due for changes that are not significant changes. Examples of minor changes include a change of flight time of less than 12 hours, changes to aircraft type and change of accommodation to another of the same standard.
- 5.3 **Force Majeure**
We shall not be in breach of our contract with you nor liable for delay in performing, or failure to perform, any of our obligations under our contract with you if such delay or failure results from events, circumstances or causes beyond our reasonable control
- (**Force Majeure Event**), including but not limited to, whether actual or threatened, war, riot, civil strife, terrorist activity, industrial dispute, natural or nuclear disaster, adverse weather conditions, epidemics, fire or unavoidable technical problems with transport.
6. **On Holiday**
- 6.1 Behaviour (refer to Hays Travel website for full booking conditions)
- 6.2 **If You Have A Complaint While You Are On Holiday**
If you have a complaint about your arrangements whilst away, you must notify the supplier of the service in question and our local agent (whose contact details can be found in your booking documentation) as soon as possible. They will do their best to rectify the situation. If you do not make your complaint as soon as possible while on holiday, this will affect our ability to investigate and take remedial action and this may affect your rights under your contract with us.
If a problem remains unresolved during your holiday, you must make a complaint in writing to us within 28 days of the completion of the holiday. Please remember to quote your holiday booking number and daytime telephone number. We will reply to you within 28 days of receipt of your written complaint.
7. **Our Liability to You**
- 7.1 This clause sets out our entire financial liability (including any liability for the acts or omissions of our employees, agents and subcontractors) to you in respect of:
7.1.1 any breach of our contract with you; or
7.1.2 any representation, statement or tortious act or omission (including negligence) arising under or in connection with our contract with you.
- 7.2 Nothing in these booking conditions shall limit or exclude our liability for:
7.2.1 death or personal injury resulting from negligence; or
7.2.2 fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation; or
7.2.3 breach of the terms implied by section 12 of the Sale of Goods Act 1979; or
7.2.4 any other liabilities for which it would be illegal or unlawful for us to limit or exclude that liability.
- 7.3 We shall not be liable to you, whether in contract, tort (including negligence) or restitution, or for breach of statutory duty or misrepresentation, or otherwise, for any damage, expense, cost or other sum or claim of any description whatsoever which results from:
7.3.1 your acts or omissions; or
7.3.2 a Force Majeure Event (see 5.3)
- 7.4 Without prejudice to clauses 7.2 and 7.3, our total liability arising under or in connection with our contract with you, whether arising in contract, tort (including negligence) or restitution, or for breach of statutory duty or misrepresentation, or otherwise, shall be limited to a maximum of three times the cost of your travel arrangements.
- 7.5 Our liability will also be limited in accordance with and/or in an identical manner to:
7.5.1 The contractual terms of our suppliers (such as airlines, accommodation or transport providers) that provide your travel arrangements. These terms are incorporated into this contract; and
7.5.2 Any relevant international convention, for example the Montreal Convention in respect of travel by air, the Athens Convention in respect of travel by sea, the Berne Convention in respect of travel by rail and the Paris Convention in respect of the provision of accommodation, which limit the amount of compensation that you can claim for death, injury, delay to passengers and loss, damage and delay to luggage. We are to be regarded as having all benefit of any limitation of compensation contained in these or any conventions.
- 7.6 Copies of the transport companies’ contractual terms, or the international conventions, are available on request.
Under EU law you have rights in some circumstances to refunds and/or compensation from your airline in cases of denied boarding, cancellation or delay to flights. Full details of these rights will be publicised at EU airports and will also be available from airlines. However reimbursement in such cases will not automatically entitle you to a refund of your holiday cost from us. If any payments to you are due from us, any payment made to you by the airline will be deducted from this amount.
- 7.7 We accept no responsibility for any services which do not form part of our contract. This includes, for example, any additional services or facilities which your hotel or any other supplier agrees to provide for you where the services or facilities are not advertised by us and we have not agreed to arrange them as part of our contract and any excursion you purchase in resort.
8. **Data Protection Policy** (refer to Hays Travel website for full booking conditions)
9. **Governing Law**
- 9.1 Your contract with us and any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with it shall be governed by the law of England and Wales.
- 9.2 You and we irrevocably agree to submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales over any claim or matter arising under or in connection with the contract between us.
